The Washington Institute 2019 Enduring Advocate Award honors an individual NCJW member who has been a leader and instrumental in advancing social change in NCJW's name in their community over a period of 10 or more years. The nominees will have advanced NCJW's mission by participating in or leading campaigns and projects that includes at least two of the following strategies: advocacy, community service, education, or community organizing.

Criteria:

- Led social change projects or efforts over a period of 10 or more years that combine at least two of the following strategies: advocacy, community service, education, and community organizing
- Furthered the mission of NCJW
- Exemplified innovation, creativity, and courage in her actions
- Served as a role model in her own section, other sections, and/or the general community
- Raised awareness of NCJW in the community through her pioneering efforts
- Mentored and motivated others
- Has been an NCJW member for more than 10 years

Questions:

A complete application will include answers to all of these questions. Please limit responses to less than 250 words for each question. Please include any other details that you find relevant, photos, or other materials associated with the project.

- Please describe the nominee in detail and provide leadership examples.
- What are the strategies most often and best used by this nominee over the years to enact social change?
- Please describe some of the nominees' social change projects or efforts?
- Please describe how the nominee has furthered the mission of NCJW?
- How has the nominee exemplified innovation, creativity and courage in their actions?
- How has the nominee served as a role model in their section, within NCJW, and/or in the general community?
- How has the nominee raised awareness and/or the profile of NCJW?
