Connecting for Impact to Combat Violence against Women



Connecting For Impact is a prestigious leadership development program for top CEOs and Executives looking to grow the feminist field in Israel and leverage their collective impact. Established in 2018 by the National Council for Jewish Women and the NCJW Program for Gender Studies at Tel Aviv University, this program directly responds to research findings that indicated the importance and vitality of creating platforms for feminist connection and collaboration.



Main topics in the program:

- 1. Feminist theories and empirical knowledge in Israel and around the world.
- 2. Best practices in eradicating violence against women.
- 3. Leadership and management tools for NGOs.
- 4. Theories and models for social change.
- 5. Sustainability.
- 6. Meet with global experts in the feminist field.



Program Objectives

- 1. Develop personally and professionally.
- 2. Strengthen organization and development of organizational capacities.
- 3. Learn feminist theories for change and practical knowledge for change making.
- 4. Create connections and empower the feminist field in Israel.

The Second Cohort is intended for organizational management and key activists in the field of prevention of violence against women in all its manifestations and the treatment of women who are the victims of violence.
