1. Introductions - quick whip-around: Name, plus just one thing that has challenged or inspired you in your social justice work - 5 minutes
2. “Speed Dating” Introductions - 20 minutes
  - a. You have about 3 minutes each to introduce yourself. What do you want people to know about you?
  - b. Why NCJW? What brought you to this organization?
  - c. What do you hope to get from your board service - how can the experience be personally enriching for you?
3. Board Book - 10 minutes

  - e. Norms, Beliefs and Practices, Community Change Principles
